## Friday, April 13: **Toast of the Town!**

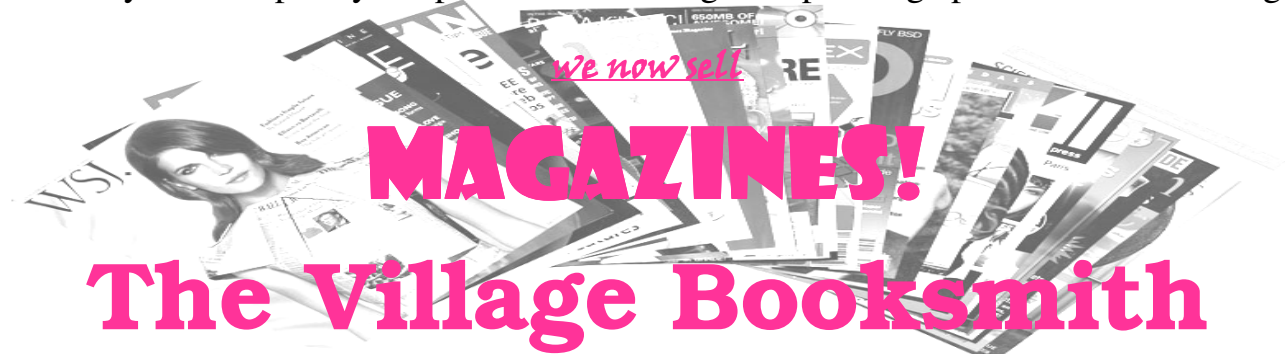
